Welcome back!!

The PAC is looking forward to another great year at Crystal View and already have a couple of events and fundraisers planned. Watch for information coming home soon.

The PAC works very hard each year on many fundraising programs. At the beginning of the school year the PAC has to establish a budget. The budget at CV typically varies between \$25,000 and \$35,000 per year. The budget is based upon annual needs at the school.

The funds raised pay for the following things at Crystal View School

- Classroom resources such as books, games, special art supplies & other class resources
- Library books & additional learning resources needed
- Music instruments and resource materials
- Field Trip Support including transportation costs
- Counseling Support for parent and student resource books, peer helper training & other resources as needed
- Student Resources cross-country snacks, Gr. 5 recognition crystals, partial cost coverage for intermediate agendas
- Special Events school-wide events, performances, presenters, beach day, fun day, literacy week, clubs etc.
- Learning Resources books, games, equipment, computer software
- Emergency Preparedness re-stock supplies
- Sports Council Membership allows our kids to take part in Handball, Basketball, Soccer, Volleyball & Track district-wide
- PAC Resources Membership Fees to district & provincial PACs, Administrative Costs, Gifts, Parent & PAC education and Bursary for Crystal View Alumni
- And many other things benefiting the 252 plus students, teachers and support staff of Crystal View.

Based on feedback, we have decided to offer the option to families to make a one-time monetary contribution to the PAC. This one time contribution will cover your fundraising fulfillment for the 2019/2020 school year.

You would still have the option to participate in the most popular fundraisers if you so choose.

If you feel you would like to choose this option, all you need to do is make a one-time contribution (suggested minimum contribution would be **\$50 per student, maximum of \$150 per family**, this is only a suggested amount.) You will not be asked to do any additional fundraising for the school year, unless you want to.
