#### Message from Ms.D.

It is not quite time for our December newsletter, but I thought I would send a second November update to ensure everyone has received the information about school catchment changes and of course to highlight some great happenings at our school!

On Thursday, Nov. 17<sup>th</sup>, I sent you a letter via email regarding revised school catchment boundaries which will take effect in School District 62, in September of 2022. The change in boundary catchment lines is to support the growth in our district and alleviate overcrowding in some of our schools. In the coming years, there will be additional new schools opening at all levels. As a recap of some of the key points, please see below.

A few of our Crystal View families currently reside at an address that will become part of the catchment for Colwood Elementary School. If your home address is now part of the catchment for Colwood Elementary, you will receive an email from the School District in early December.

If you would prefer to have your child remain at Crystal View next September, there will be an online District process to follow. Parents/ Guardians will need to indicate their request for their child to remain at Crystal View by filling in a School Change Request (SCR).

This process will open on January 4<sup>th</sup> and will close on January 14<sup>th</sup>, 2022, prior to our regular registration week. Parents will be notified about the outcome of this request in late-January. Transportation will be available to students who require service to an "in-catchment" school.

**Kindergarten Registration**- Please Note: As of January 2022, all new students including those registering for Kindergarten for September 2022 will be directed to attend their catchment school. For example, if your address has changed to the Colwood catchment and you have pre-school aged children who are not yet attending school, they will be automatically directed to register at Colwood Elementary. Sibling registration requests at out of catchment schools will not be granted.
